The Position: University College of the North requires an instructor(s) to teach Aboriginal and Northern Counseling Skills in The Pas, Manitoba. Classes will be held Mondays and Wednesday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Classes will be scheduled as follows:

- 2 weeks' preparation prior to classes
- Classes September 4, 2018 to April 30, 2020
- 1 week wrap up at the end of the program May 1-7, 2020

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in Counseling, Social Work or related degree
- Advanced knowledge of Aboriginal counseling skills and techniques
- Experience teaching adults
- Minimum 2 years' experience counseling adults, children and youth
- Proven ability to develop course content utilizing Aboriginal paradigm
- Effective interpersonal skills and demonstrated leadership abilities
- Effective organizational skills
- Proficient in the use of technology
- Excellent communication skills
- Demonstrated creative/culturally relevant instructional practices with adult and Aboriginal learners
- Personal experience and/or knowledge and understanding of the Indigenous cultures

Assets:

- The ability to speak an Aboriginal language
- Experience in instructing Aboriginal and adult learners in northern or remote communities.

Conditions of Employment:

- Candidates must be legally entitled to work in Canada

Applicants must provide a cover letter, résumé and references with their application.
Applicants must demonstrate on their résumé how they meet the qualifications.

Representative Workforce (formerly employment equity) is a factor in the selection process. Preference will be given to Aboriginal candidates. Applicants are invited to indicate in their covering letter or résumé if they are from any of the following groups: Aboriginal people, persons with disabilities, visible minorities, or women and men in non-traditional roles. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority.
