The Position: UCN requires a Paramedic Instructor to teach the Paramedic Program in The Pas, Manitoba. This program is scheduled to commence in September 2018. In addition to teaching duties, the instructor will be responsible for classroom management, student supervision and advising, maintenance of student records and grades, curriculum review/development and other administrative tasks.

Qualifications:

- Duly qualified Primary Care Paramedic or Advanced Care Paramedic
- Valid Provincial Paramedic License
- A minimum of five years of recent work experience in acute care is preferred
- Effective interpersonal skills
- Effective communication skills
- Effective organizational skills
- Strong critical thinking and problem solving skills
- Strong computer skills (Microsoft Office)
- Demonstrated ability to understand cultural influences and issues specific to Indigenous learners and mature students in northern communities
- Personal experience and/or knowledge and understanding of the Indigenous cultures

- The ability to speak an Indigenous language
- Previous instructional experience
- Familiarity with curriculum development and delivery

Conditions of Employment:

- Candidates must be legally entitled to work in Canada

- Must be willing to travel

Applicants must provide a cover letter, résumé, and references with their application.

Applicants must demonstrate on their résumé how they meet the qualifications.

Representative Workforce (formerly employment equity) is a factor in the selection process. Preference will be given to Indigenous candidates. Applicants are invited to indicate in their covering letter or résumé if they are from any of the following groups: Indigenous people, persons with disabilities, visible minorities, or women and men in non-traditional roles. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority.
