**The Position:** UCN requires an instructor to teach Small Motor Repair in Grand Rapids, Manitoba. In addition to teaching duties, the instructor will be responsible for related duties including classroom management, student supervision, maintenance of student records and grades, curriculum refinement and other administrative tasks.

### Qualifications:

- Minimum of Certificate or OEM certified training in Outdoor Power Equipment Repair, Small Motor Repair, Marine Motor Repair or Motorcycle Mechanics
- Significant experience in the repair and maintenance of snowmobiles, outboard motors, all-terrain vehicles and other small motor-powered equipment
- Good communication skills (both oral and written)
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Effective organizational skills
- Effective time management skills
- Excellent computer skills (MS Office)
- Demonstrated ability to understand and to deal with issues specific to Aboriginal learners and mature students in northern communities
- Personal experience and/or knowledge and understanding of Aboriginal cultures

- The ability to speak an Aboriginal language

- Candidates must be legally entitled to work in Canada
