The Position: University College of the North requires an Instructor to teach Social Science courses within the Faculty of Arts, Business and Science program at The Pas Campus. In addition to teaching duties, the Instructor will be responsible for related duties including classroom management, student supervision, maintenance of student records and grades, curriculum refinement and other administrative tasks.

Qualifications:

- A Graduate degree in Sociology or a related discipline with specialization in the areas of globalization, social movements, race, class, gender, sexuality, feminism, and social justice
- Experience teaching in a post-secondary environment
- Working knowledge of MS Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint)
- Effective communication skills
- Effective interpersonal skills
- Strong organizational skills
- Excellent teamwork and time management skills
- Experience working in an online/virtual environment using various Learning Management Systems (Adobe, Zoom, D2L, etc)

- Personal experience and/or knowledge and understanding of Indigenous cultures

Applicants are invited to indicate in their covering letter or résumé if they are from any of the following groups: Indigenous people, persons with disabilities, visible minorities, or women and men in non-traditional roles. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority.
