Submission Guidelines

1. Please submit your entry for the anthology as a Word (written submission) or RTF (artwork) document.
2. Please include a title page with your entry (poetry, prose, or artwork). This page should contain the title of the manuscript, the author's name, and the author's school.
3. Short stories and creative non-fiction should be double-spaced. Please use Ariel 12-point font.
4. Poetry should be submitted in Ariel 12-point font. The choice of line spacing is up to the author.
5. There are no restrictions regarding manuscript length.
6. The title of your work and page number should appear on each page in a header or footer.
7. Each entry needs to be accompanied by a completed submission form.
8. Please submit entries electronically to Dr. Carolyn Creed at ccreed@ucn.ca. The deadline for submissions is **Friday, April 5, 2019**.
