Eligibility for Disability Support Services

Students are eligible to obtain support services if they have one of, but not limited to, the following types of disabilities:

- Vision/hearing impairment
- Neurological conditions
- Mobility/coordination
- Psychological/psychiatric conditions
- Developmental disability
- Chronic health problems
- Documented Learning Disabilities
- Temporary and episodic disabilities



Requirements to Register for Disability Support Services

- Register with SAS and provide sufficient documentation of diagnosis to SAS that supports the disability.
- Make arrangements for accommodations in a timely manner.

Available Services

- Accommodations are provided on an individual basis
- Assessment for accommodation needs
- Alternate format materials
- Proper assistive devices and equipment
- Separate space for tests and exams.
- Extended time for tests, assignments or exams.
- Referrals and requests to external agencies for additional support (SMD, CNIB)
