Carpooling allows you to share the cost of gas and parking, cutting your expenses by nearly 50% or more; the more occupants in your carpool the more you save. Carpooling is also socially economical. Not only will you be saving, but you will also help reduce the costs we all pay towards the construction of new roads, road maintenance and air pollution related health costs. Driving can be alternated on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis. Costs are incurred only during the period in which you are required to drive—put simply—when you drive you pay, when you ride it's free.

Having fewer cars on the road means reduced Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions and improved air quality.

***It's good for your health.**
